### Winemaking Notes

For the last several vintages, Long Haul's formation has been inspired by the great Right Bank blends of Bordeaux, with Merlot and Cabernet Franc making up the majority of the blend. In 2014 the decision was made to return Long Haul to its roots and create a blend reminiscent of the Long Haul blends prior to 2008. The 2014 Long Haul is composed primarily of Merlot from Ciel du Cheval, a vineyard planted on calcium-rich clay beds that give the wine a rich, delicate texture and feminine aromatics. Yakima Valley's Red Willow Vineyard provides a vastly different aromatic profile, offering complexity and broadness to the palate. The warm 2014 vintage allowed us to harvest all of Long Haul's components in the month of September, between the 2nd and 23rd. As in years past, every lot was fermented in 1.5 and 2 ton open-top fermenters for 9 to 12 days. Every effort is made to treat the wine as gently as possible; the must is never put through pumps and is gently punched down twice per day. Fermentation rounds are performed to monitor fermentation and track when the wines are ready to be lightly pressed into barrel, where it finishes primary and malolactic fermentation. The wine was aged in 47% new French oak for 21 months and was racked twice prior to being bottled on June 13th, 2016.

## Tasting Notes

"The 2014 Long Haul Ciel du Cheval Vineyard was shifted to a more Merlot dominated blend in 2014. It offers plenty of currants, plums, spice and cedar characteristics in ripe, sexy, slightly straightforward style. It has good, not great concentration, but should certainly be outstanding."
