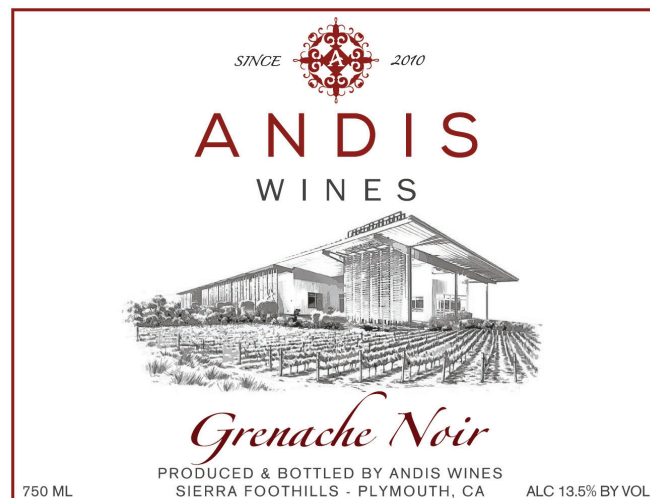


GRENACHE NOIR

Winemaker Notes

Andis Grenache Noir is made using grapes sourced from vineyards in the Sierra Foothills, which are located at higher elevations. The wine is perfectly balanced, boasting a nervy acidity that complements the delicious flavors of raspberry and cranberry. It has a pale ruby color and subtle hints of red cherries, currant, and licorice. Grenache is typically known for its low tannin profile; however, it still delivers a high-quality, medium-bodied red wine with a long, soft, velvety finish.
