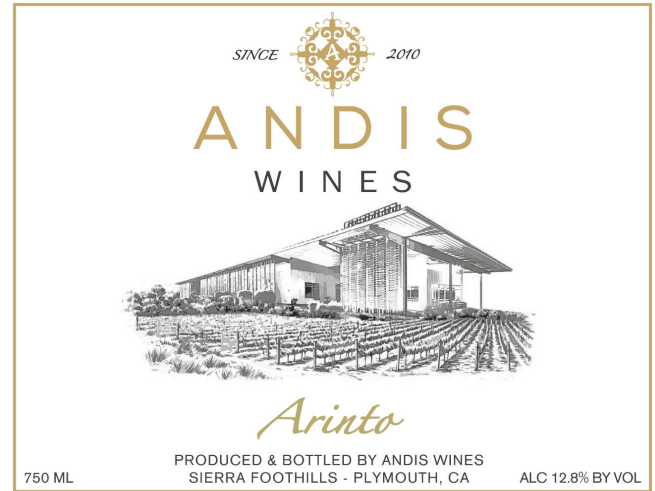

Winemaker Notes

Arinto (pronounced ah-RINN-toh) is a native grape variety from Portugal. Andis was the first winery to plant this variety in our region back in 2016. Arinto is known for its bone-dry character, rich texture, and refreshing crispness, and it boasts high acidity. The grape features aromas of white flowers and offers flavors of citrus and stone fruits, including lemon, lime, and peach, all complemented by mineral notes.
