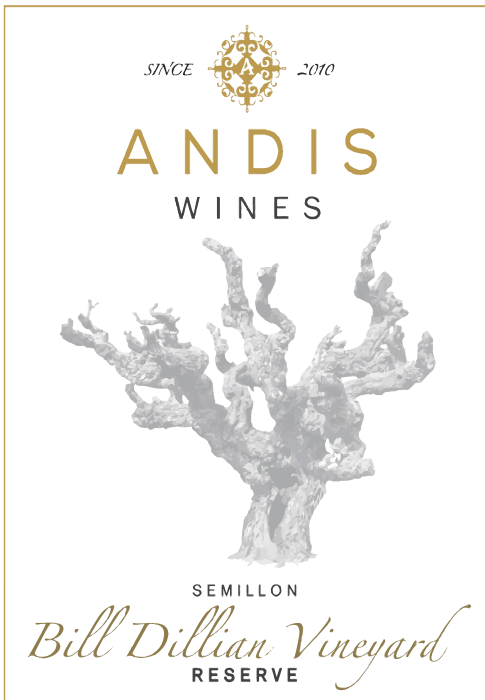

Vineyard Notes

Over 40 years ago, a visionary grape grower named Bill Dillian planted these beautiful, head-trained Semillon vines in the sandy soils of California Shenandoah Valley AVA. Andis Wines took the chance on producing wine from this vineyard without knowing that one day it would be recognized by critics as a "Hidden Gem of California". The unique micro-climate and the high elevation of the Sierra Foothills develop a fruit with great acidity and balance.

Winemaker Notes

Fresh herbs and dried apples lead to a rather rich, layered palate. Sharp and cleansing with layers of lemon zest and pith, honeysuckle and ocean spray. Mouthwatering crushed shell acidity with starfruit and a lengthy finish.
