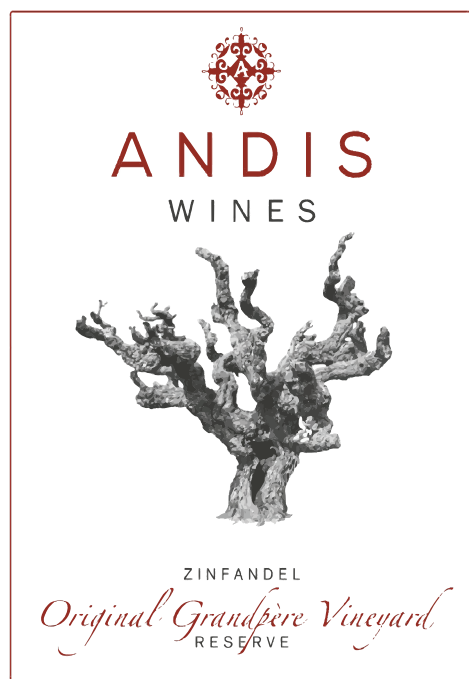


ORIGINAL GRANDPÈRE ZINFANDEL



Vineyard Notes

Planted around 1869, the Original Grandpère Vineyard is claimed to be one of the oldest documented Zinfandel vineyards in California and still in production today. It's one of the true icons of the California Shenandoah Valley AVA. The dry farmed head-trained vines planted in sandy soils yield only around 2 tons per acre of concentrated and delicate fruit.

Winemaker Notes

The wine has spicy herbs and red fruit jam backed by a nice acidity. Black tea flavors are in the nose, and wine and oak have a beautiful integration. The refined tannin makes this elegant red wine a true representation of the Sierra Foothills. It is aged and rounded and has firm yet delicate tannins.
