


BILL DILLIAN VINEYARD

Vineyard Notes

Over 40 years ago, a visionary grape grower named Bill Dillian planted these beautiful, head-trained Sémillon vines in the sandy soils of California Shenandoah Valley AVA. Andis Wines took the chance on producing wine from this vineyard without knowing that one day it would be recognized by critics as a "Hidden Gem of California". The unique micro-climate and the high elevation of the Sierra Foothills develop a fruit with great acidity and balance.

Winemaker Notes

The aroma features clean notes of straw, Meyer lemons, and lime zest. On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied, with vibrant acidity and flavors of green papaya, nectarines, and orange blossoms.
