Production Notes

Our 2022 Sparkling Rosé, is a blend of Mourvèdre from Canyon's Vineyard and Grenache from Blue Mountain Vineyard & Summit View Vineyard. All of these grapes are farmed, harvested and fermented specifically for Rosé wine.

Vineyards


- Blue Mountain Vineyard, Walla Walla Valley
- Canyon's Vineyard, Red Mountain
- Summit View Vineyard, Walla Walla Valley

Winemaking

- Hand harvested grapes
- Picked early in the morning
- Fruit was destemmed and left on skins for an average of 4 hours
- Small lot fermentations at cool temperature in stainless steel tanks
- The wine was blended and aged for 6 months in stainless steel
- Light fining and cross flow filtration prior to bottling

Vintage

- 2022 was cooler than average growing season overall.
- Bloom and bud break were delayed slightly due to cooler temperatures with increased moisture throughout May.
- The summer months were consistently warm allowing us to catch up some on long term averages, with verasion occurring about two weeks later than normal.
- Harvest began on September 22nd and lasted through October 28th
- This vintage has led to increased hangtime in all varietals, developing complex wines with good natural acids and beautiful fruit expression.
