2020 BRUT NATURE Estate Grown, Dry Creek Valley



VINTAGE DESCRIPTION:

2020 was a warm vintage with extremely low rainfall during the winter and a warmer than average spring. This led to an earlier budbreak. The warm weather continued through the growing season and accelerated the harvest by almost 3 weeks. The lack of rain led to an exceptionally low yield in the vineyard which helped create a nice intensity in each of the wines.

TASTING NOTES

Tasting Notes: This wine is one of my absolute favorites. In the glass it is pale yellow in color with just the slightest hint of any hue that gives away that it is made of Zinfandel. The bubbles are so beautiful and intense from the long aging. Aromatically, there are notes of white raspberry, slight orange marmalade, lemon chiffon, toasted hazelnuts and slight buttery pie crust notes. The palate is filled with bright fruit notes and lots of white and yellow floral notes on the front. The finish is so balanced with slightly toasty notes and a long and lingering finish. The no dosage really allows the fruit to shine through in a beautiful way. This wine is delicious and will lay down quite well for a longer aging.
