Production Notes

To achieve a darker color and more robust palate presence, the Malbec grapes we use to produce this wine are destemmed and pumped into a tank (not unlike what we do with red wine) where the juice is allowed to sit in contact with the skins, seeds, and pulp overnight. In that overnight period, color and tannin are extracted into the juice, yielding a darker, more structured rosé. Bottled 1/18/2024. 492 cases produced.

Winemaker's Notes

Even though this Malbec is done in a rosé style, classic notes of strawberry jam with subtle black pepper undertones show in the glass. On the palate, the wine displays a unique texture/structure for a rosé due to the overnight skin contact the juice is allowed. Crisp acidity and just a touch of residual sugar help to balance the light tannins and support the fruitfulness the wine displays.
