

Taste Messina Hof history in a glass. Each vintage is unique due to weather conditions in the vineyard, harvesting timing and methods, winemaking techniques, and blending – to name a few. We invite you to go back in time and experience these vintages, hand-selected by the Winemaker, for your personal enjoyment and enlightenment. "Library wine" is the term often used to describe vintages that are held back by the Winemaker to be cellared for aging and re-released years after the original debut. The name stems from our private cellars that we refer to as "libraries" where these wines age.
