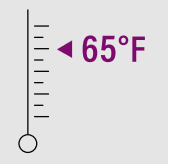

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

TRUFFLE · FIG · BROWN SUGAR

This Cabernet Sauvignon opens with earthy aromas of truffle and tobacco. On the palate, notes of fig, dried blueberry, and brown sugar bring warmth, balanced by a subtle bitterness of blackberry and a touch of cocoa. A softer profile leads into a structured finish with chalky tannins. Pair with roasted meats or mushroom-forward dishes.
