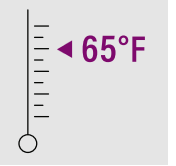

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

SMOKE · BLACKBERRY · OLIVE

This Mourvèdre is a bold dry red wine with rustic elegance. A smokiness can be picked up on the nose with earthy tones. Black fruit flavors alongside hints of olive marinate the palate and provide a natural roundness. Mourvèdre pairs well with wild game or smoked red meats seasoned with spice or fresh ground black pepper.
