



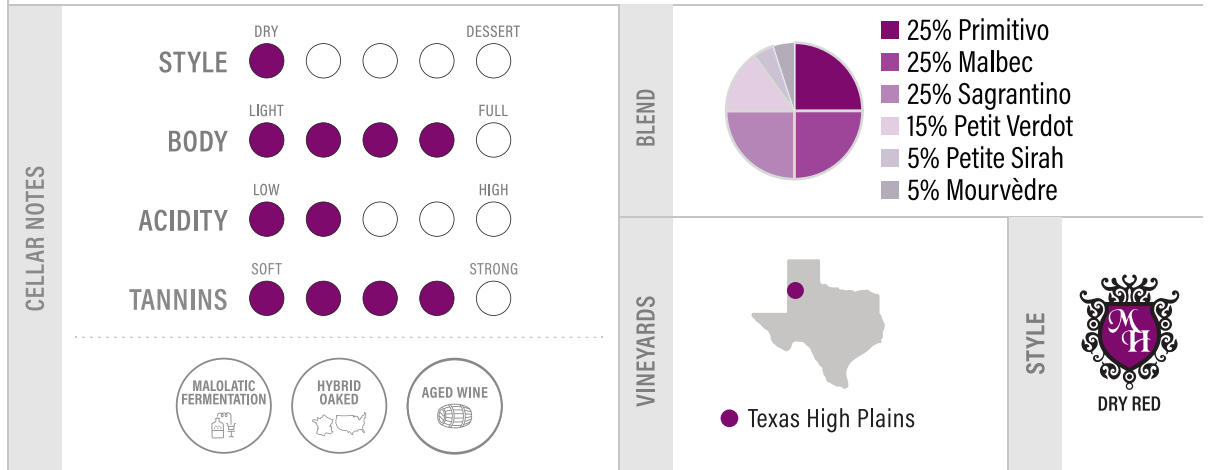

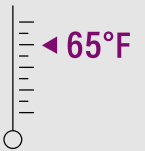


WINEMAKER'S NOTES

BLACKBERRY · CHERRY · VANILLA

Deep in color and elegantly composed, this dry red blend reveals aromas of blackberry, rose, and subtle potpourri. Flavors of cherry, cranberry, and plum unfold alongside warm vanilla and a touch of smoke, balanced by plush, woody tannins and a gentle, lingering tartness. Its delicate yet structured profile makes it a graceful pairing for beef, lamb, game meats, or aged cheeses.
