

Aromas of toast and roasted vanilla layered over hints of butter introduce you to this aged Chardonnay. On the palate, notes of baked lemon and toasted oak add depth to the wine's round, creamy texture. Barrel aging has shaped a beautiful white wine with surprisingly decadent flavors.
