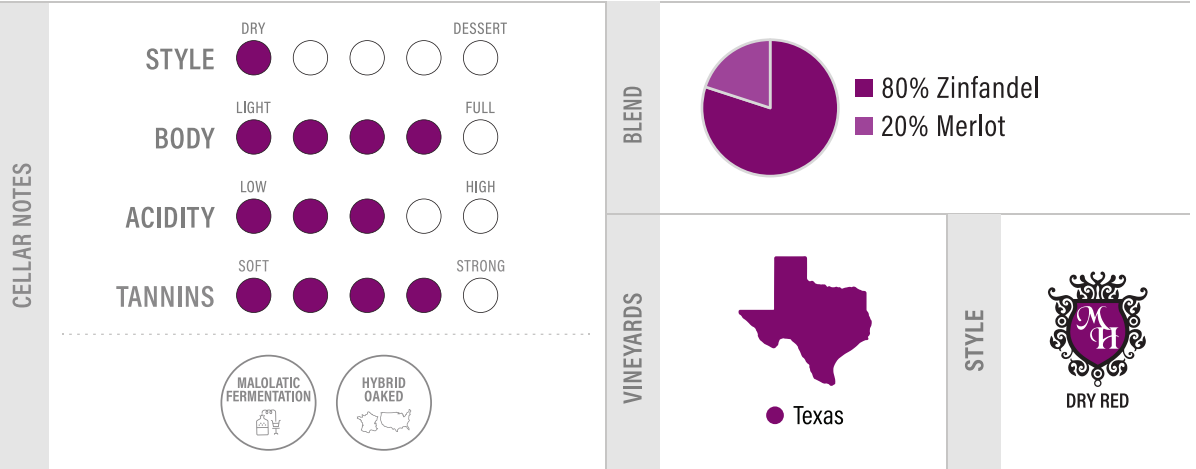

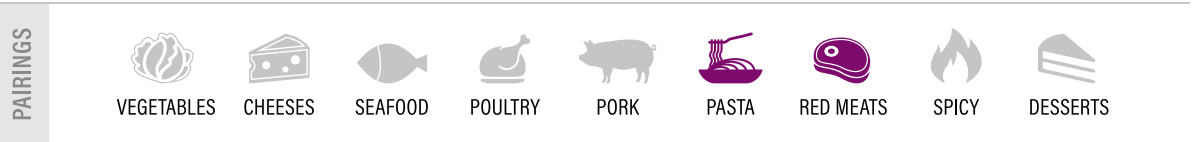
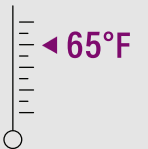


WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This mature Zinfandel has aged into aromas of cocoa powder, roasted hazelnut, and woody notes. Jammy red fruit flavors still shine alongside smooth tannins that create a surprisingly soft sip. Allow to breathe before serving to unlock its full potential.

"Library wine" is the term often used to describe vintages that are held back by the Winemaker to be cellared for aging and re-released years after the original debut.
