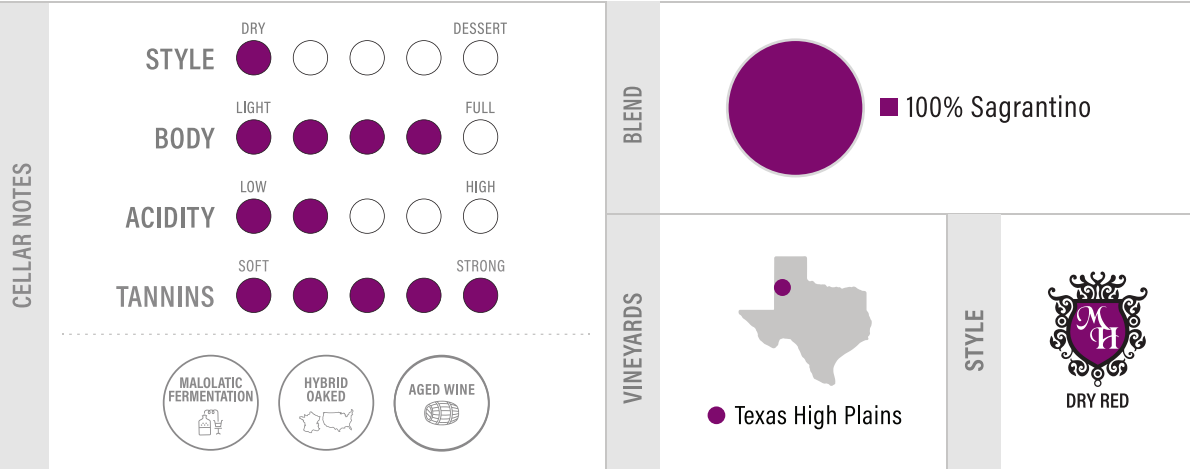

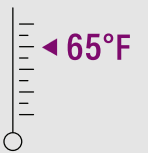











WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Rustic and expressive, the 2017 Sagrantino Reserva has aromas of dried herbs and tomato leaf, leading into layers of cherry and bramble berry. Black pepper and hints of fennel sausage lend a meaty complexity to the palate. This wine is aging gracefully and makes a bold companion to hearty, savory dishes.
