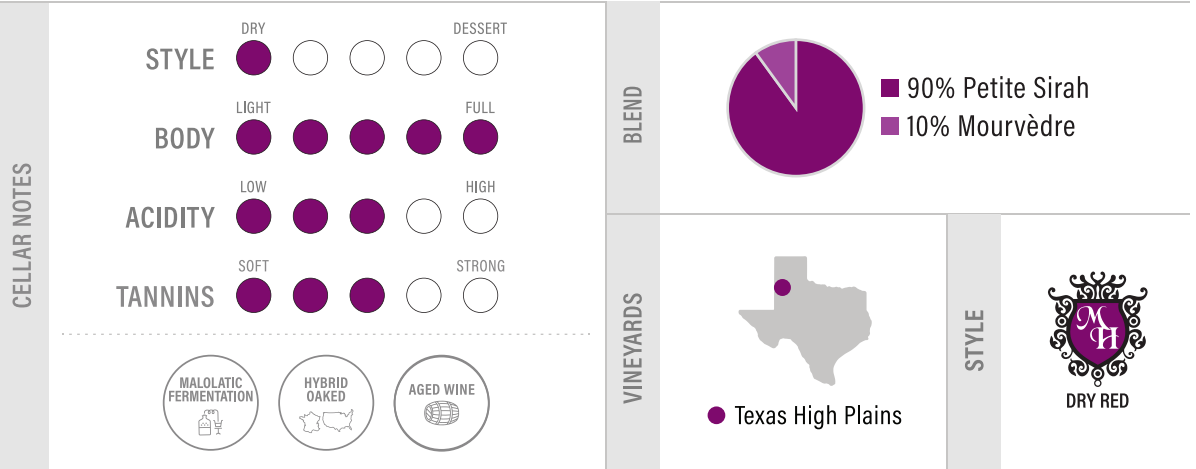

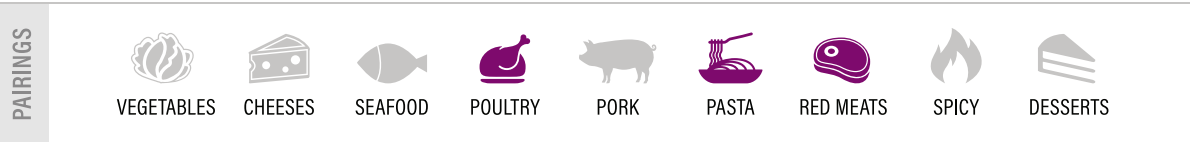
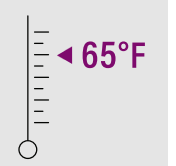


WINEMAKER'S NOTES

FIG · DRIED FRUIT · CRANBERRY

This beautifully aged Petite Sirah has developed rich layers of complexity. Aromas of fig, dried fruit, and cranberry intertwine with subtle notes of clove and earthy mushroom. The palate is bold yet refined, featuring flavors cherry pie filling, accented by hints of vanilla and cinnamon. Integrated tannins and texture make this wine an excellent companion to hearty dishes and herbaceous flavors.

"Library wine" is the term often used to describe vintages that are held back by the Winemaker to be cellared for aging and re-released years after the original debut.
