Cabernet Franc is known as an ancient grape varietal, and is the father of Cabernet Sauvignon. When Paul Vincent and Merrill Bonarrigo went to St. Emilion in the early 1990s, they visited Chateau Ausone. They remembered the wonderful aromas in the wines and decided to pursue Cabernet Franc for Texas.
