Winery:

Idilico is Pomum Cellars' sister brand focusing exclusively on Spanish varietal wines grown in Washington State. The goal for Idilico wines, is to bring to the consumer's attention the potential of Spanish varietals in the great Washington State terroirs of the Yakima Valley.

Wine:

Originally from growing areas in the southeast of Spain this variety is also known as Mourvèdre in France and typically showcases tart dark cherry, freshly crushed pepper and some game notes. In Washington the fruit retains great acidity due to our cool nights at harvest giving this wine great freshness and lower alcohol levels.

The 2023 vintage at Konnowac Vineyard began with an unusually cool spring, delaying bud break by a couple of weeks. Once the signature Eastern Washington warmth arrived in mid to late May, vine growth accelerated quickly. By bloom in June, the vineyard was already running ahead of historical averages. Harvest kicked off in early September, driven largely by our characteristically low yields, which tend to promote earlier ripening. Fortunately, the season unfolded smoothly and steadily, with our final pick in mid-October—just slightly ahead of schedule.

Fermented for 10 days on its skins and aged in 225 liter neutral, French cooperage for 9 months. Bottled July 2024.
