The 2018 Levitation Syrah is 100% Syrah from Lewis Vineyard, in the Yakima Valley AVA, and Les Collines Vineyard, in the Walla Walla AVA. Aged for 16 months in a combination of concrete, neutral French oak, and 25% new French oak, the final blend includes about 17% whole cluster, foot-stomped bunches. The resulting wine is exotic and aromatic. Dark red in color, with dramatic aromatics of roasted meats, bacon fat, and damp earth, the wine presents flavors of raspberries, blackberries, black cherries, and more roasted meats. The finish is persistent and lengthy, and this wine should age beautifully for the next 10-15 years.

"Also not yet bottled, the 2018 Syrah Levitation Reserve comes from the Lewis and Les Collines Vineyards and was 83% destemmed and is still aging in a mix of concrete and French oak barrels. Awesome notes of blueberries, ground pepper, leafy herbs, crushed violets, and hints of smoked game all flow to a medium to fullbodied, balanced, layered wine that has stunning purity as well as length. This is beautiful stuff that's going to drink nicely for over a decade."
