TASTING NOTES

This spectacular Cabernet is sourced from Bacchus Vineyard Block 10. Planted in 1972, this is the oldest production Cabernet Sauvignon block in the state of Washington and produces fruit that showcases the history of the vineyard. Characteristics of candied cherry and ripe raspberry develop and integrate with hints of complex spices, brown sugar, and vanilla. With bright acidity and light tannic structure, the finish is long and balanced.

WINEMAKING

- Destemmed and Fermented in Small Lots for 30 Days
- Cold Soak – 6 Days
- Extended Maceration – 8 Days
- 50% New French Oak
- 50% Once Filled French Oak
- Aged in 225L Barrique Barrels for 18 Months

VINEYARD

- Bacchus Vineyard
Block 10 – Planted in 1972 is the oldest commercial producing block of Cab Sauv in the state
