From the Steven Gribaudo Vineyards in Acampo Lodi AVA to “the highest and coldest winery” where winemaker Katy Carroll Jones allowed an extended skin contact time of the Pinot Grigio grapes in order to develop a perfect blush of color and a supple flavor and finish.

Tasting Notes:

A light corral pink with copper tinges, much like a Tahoe sunset. Fresh and elegant with pleasant fruit tones of peach and apricot, fun and fruity citrus notes and aromas of white blossom.

A dry, well structured ramato with balanced acidity and a delicate mineral note in the finish.

Food Pairing Notes: Our Ramato of Pinot Grigio goes particularly well with fish courses (shellfish in particular), rice, poultry and fresh cheeses. This is a perfect aperitif or sunset wine!
