### VINTAGE NOTE

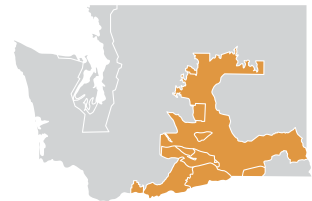
The 2020 growing season proved to be an excellent year, particularly for red varieties. Quality from this vintage has proven excellent due to stellar weather. Beautiful growing conditions during maturation and low disease pressure gave our winemakers a promising start. Smaller-than-anticipated tons per acre and relatively small berry size allowed the grapes to ripen earlier than prior years. The vineyard teams harvested earlier than usual while the weather outside was ideal. At harvest, the reds were expressing exceptional fruity characteristics and darker colors, promising more intense flavor concentrations in the end result. Ultimately, 2020 delivered a high-quality harvest.

### VINEYARDS

#### 100% Skyfall Vineyard

One of the most diverse wine grape growing regions in Washington, its location in the rain shadow gives the

Columbia Valley AVA 300 days of sun per year, which leads to wines with naturally bright acidity and fruity characteristics.
