Rich aromas of blackberries and black currants carry through the palate with balanced tannins and a nice French oak influence.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2020 growing season proved to be an excellent year. Quality from this vintage has proven excellent due to stellar weather. Beautiful growing conditions during maturation and low disease pressure gave our winemakers a promising start. Smaller than anticipated tons per acre and relatively small berry size allowed the grapes to ripen earlier than prior years. The vineyard teams harvested earlier than usual while the weather outside was ideal. Most lots expressed exceptional fruity characteristics and darker colors, promising more intense flavor concentrations in the end result.
