

TASTING NOTE

This Cabernet Sauvignon has a rich aroma of earth and forest, along with black plum. It's a full-bodied wine with strong flavors of leather, anise, and black fruits. The tannins are textured and leave a finish of black coffee and dark chocolate that makes your mouth water. Pair this rich wine with roasted lamb and a hearty tomato sauce.

VINTAGE NOTE

The 2022 harvest had a slow start in Washington due to an unusually wet and snowy spring. Despite a few days with temperatures breaking 100°F, temperatures across the state tended to stay within the optimal ripening zone throughout the summer months. While autumnal rain falls further delayed the completion of harvest until late November, fruit was plentiful. The red varietals from this 2022 vintage have great color and intensity with earthy notes and big tannins.
