This Rocks District wine shows jammy notes of blueberries and chewy blackberries, terroir of wet stones, asian spice box, and lavender aromas with voluptuous tannins.

VINEYARD NOTES

Hallowed Stones Estate Vineyard Watermill's flagship property and the "jewel within the crown" of our vineyard holdings. Located entirely within the Rocks District of Milton-Freewater AVA, this region is regarded as the best in the Walla Walla Valley, and consistently outscores lesser Walla Walla Valley appellation wines. The Rocks District AVA was viewed as unworkable due to the presence of large cobblestones covering the ground that are remnants of the former riverbed that once covered the southern portion of the Walla Walla Valley floor.
